<b>Major takeaway:</b> I can have a relationship with HS. This relationship is personal, intentional, and intimate.

### II. The Work of the Holy Spirit

A. The Work of Holy Spirit In Relationship to Jesus Christ

Key Verses: Acts 10

#### **Major Takeaways:**

- 1. Christ was sent into the world by Father and Holy Spirit (Isaiah 48:16)
- 2. Conceived in Mary's womb by Holy Spirit (Luke 1:5)
- 3. Jesus rose as a human through the work of Holy Spirit (Luke 2:40)
- 4. Jesus was led into the wilderness by Holy Spirit (Matthew 4:1)
  - a. Holy Spirit will get you into trouble on purpose (good trouble)



- b. Obedience to Holy Spirit can lead to ridicule. This will be the contention in every obedience Believer
- 5. Jesus attributes His preaching to Holy Spirit (Luke 4:18)
- 6. Performs mighty miracles through the power of Holy Spirit (Acts 10:38)

7. Casts out demons through the power of Holy Spirit (Matthew 12:28)

### B. The Work of Holy Spirit In Relationship to the Believer

Key Verses: John 14, Ephesians 5:15-16

#### **Major Takeaways:**

- 1. Holy Spirit reveals the will of God the Father and Jesus to ALL believers
- 2. Believers are born again through the work of Holy Spirit (John 3:5-6)
- 3. Believers receive a new spiritual life through the indwelling of Holy Spirit

  (Romans 8:9)
- 4. Holy Spirit bears witness to the believer's sonship (Galatians 3:26; Romans 8:16)
- 5. Holy Spirit seals the believer (Ephesians 1:13-14)



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	he Ministry of the Holy Spirit
<u>key v</u>	<u>erses:</u> <mark>2 Corinthians 3, 2 Corinthians 4, Romans 8:13</mark>
<u>Major</u>	Takeaways:
1.	Whatever you learn of Holy Spirit it can be trusted as truth, because Holy Spirit is a Teacher. (John 16:13; combination 15:26; 14:26)
2.	Holy Spirit will reveal God's words and desires towards us (John 16:12-13)
3.	Holy Spirit reminds believers of the promises, commandments, and instructions of the Scriptures ( <i>John 15:20</i> )

### A. What Is It?

<u>Key Verses:</u> Romans 6:3-5, Galatians 3:27, Acts 2:37-38, Acts 10;47-48, Acts 1:8, 1 Corinthians
2:4, Ephesians 6:12, 2 Corinthians 10:3-5, 1 John 4:4, John 7:37-39, Ephesians <u>3</u> :20, Matthew 10:1,
Matthew 28:19, Mark 16:16, Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8, Acts 2:38, Ephesians 5:18

Key Verses: Galatians 3:14, Hebrews 11:6, Acts 2:38, Hebrews 6:1
Major Takeaways:
How to receive the Holy Spirit:
1. By faith
2. By fully yielding to the directives of Holy Spirit
3. By tarrying



Key Verses: Acts 2:4, Acts 19:6, Acts 2:42, Acts 13:1-3, John 15:26

### V. The Fruit of the Spirit

Key Verses: Galatians 5:22-23, Romans 8, John 15:8

C. Evidence of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

#### **Major Takeaways:**

- 1. Spirit-filled fruitfulness is available to surrendered believers. You must surrender to Holy Spirit in order to bear fruit. (Galatians 5:22-23);
- 2. The fruit of the Spirit is a true characteristic of a spirit-filled life.
- 3. You cannot bear fruit in your works (*John 15:8*). You must abide in the vine. Fruit-bearing is a result of a life connected to the vine.
- 4. Bear much fruit (be in the vine, be pruned, and endure cuts). We only see fruit when we allow ourselves to (John 15-Galatians 5; Acts 2)
- 5. The relationship between the Believer and the Vine must be bred out of faith. If not, when storms come, you'll disconnect.
