A. The Work of Holy Spirit In Relationship to Jesus Christ

Key Verses: Acts 10

Major Takeaways:

1. Christ was sent into the world by Father and Holy Spirit (Isaiah 48:16)
2. Conceived in Mary's womb by Holy Spirit (Luke 1:5)
3. Jesus rose as a human through the work of Holy Spirit (Luke 2:40)
4. Jesus was led into the wilderness by Holy Spirit (Matthew 4:1)
 - a. Holy Spirit will get you into trouble on purpose (good trouble)



5. Jesus attributes His preaching to Holy Spirit **(Luke 4:18)**
6. Performs mighty miracles through the power of Holy Spirit **(Acts 10:38)**
7. Casts out demons through the power of Holy Spirit **(Matthew 12:28)**

1. Spirit-filled fruitfulness is available to surrendered believers. You must surrender to Holy Spirit in order to bear fruit. **(Galatians 5:22-23);**
2. The fruit of the Spirit is a true characteristic of a spirit-filled life.
3. You cannot bear fruit in your works **(John 15:8);** You must abide in the vine. Fruit-bearing is a result of a life connected to the vine.
4. Bear much fruit (be in the vine, be pruned, and endure cuts). We only see fruit when we allow ourselves to **(John 15-Galatians 5; Acts 2)**
5. The relationship between the Believer and the Vine must be bred out of faith. If not, when storms come, you'll disconnect.
